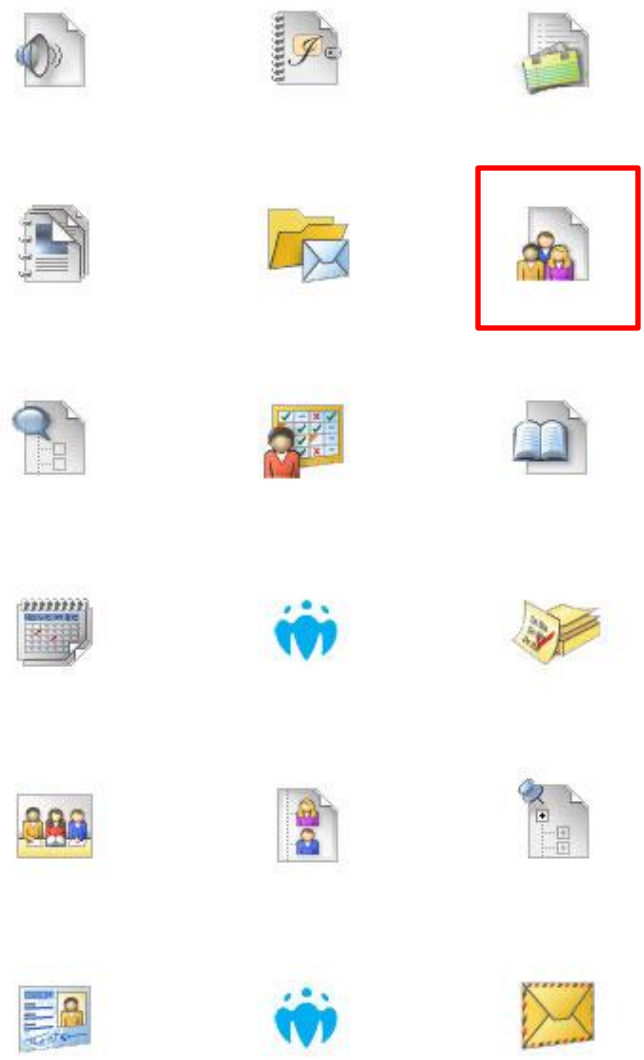

- ❑ Viewing group members

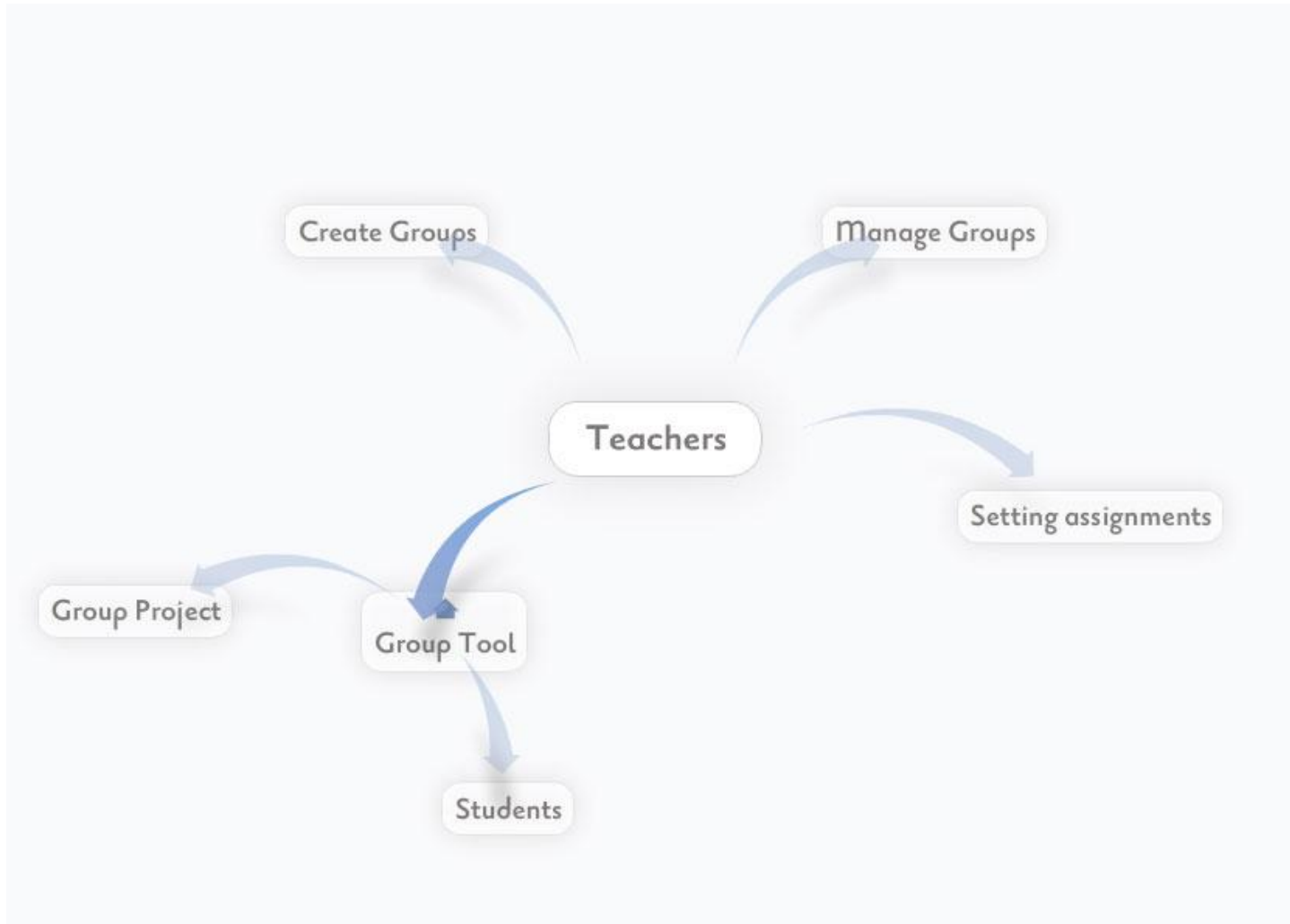


WHY USE THE GROUP TOOL?

- Select assignments that create interdependence
- Students must view it as a benefit to their learning
- Can create a single assignment and assign it to all groups, or several unique assignments
- Need to provide rubrics and guidelines

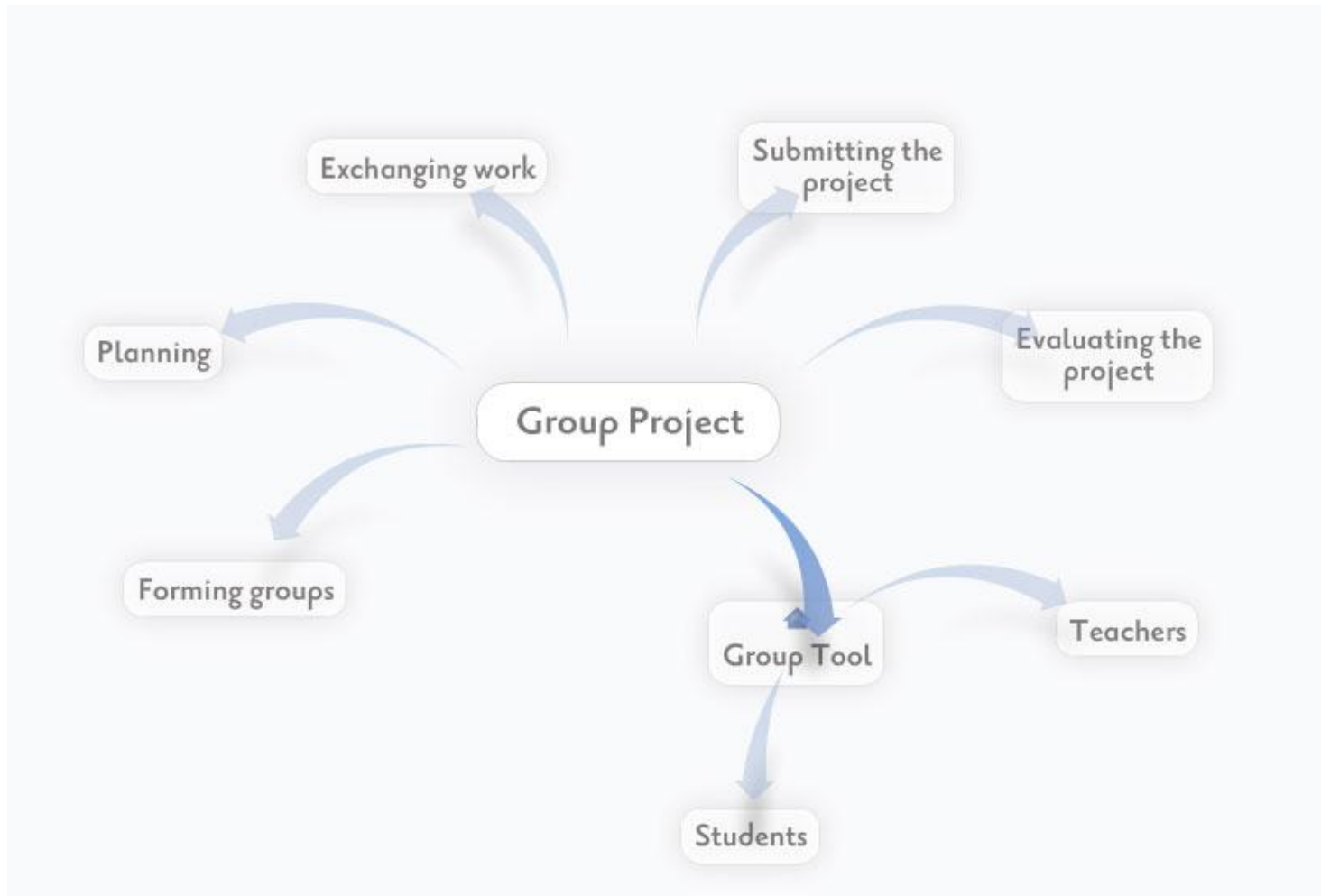


EXEMPLARY USES OF GROUP TOOL

Goal	Use of technology
Prepare SS for success	Chat/discussion/FAQs for direction & technical issues
Instructor presence	Feedback/enroll in groups
Set timelines	Announcements/emails to remind SS of due dates
Provide objectives & instructions	Assignment overview, rubric, task checklists and resources
Promote sharing	Teach ways to share ideas using tools
Keep it interesting	Assign unique case studies to each group; role-play

BENEFITS FOR TEACHING & LEARNING

- ❑ Students retain information longer
- ❑ Different perspectives offer new ways of learning
- ❑ Students are more positive about content
- ❑ A more positive & constructive learning experience
- ❑ Better social and communication skills
- ❑ Students increase their critical thinking, and problem-solving skills through peer assessment
- ❑ More opportunities for students in large classes








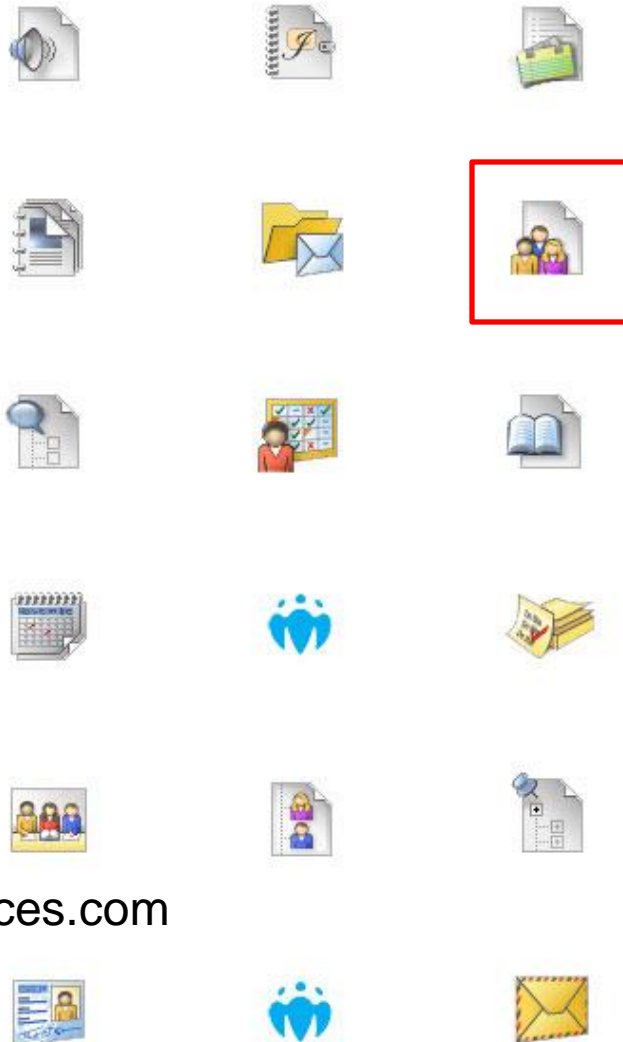
